North Shore is a premier golf club located on the upper fringes of the Waitemata Harbour, adjacent to the fast-growing Albany area.

A feature of the club is the 27 championship-quality golf holes located in a beautiful bush setting, offering members and visitors the option of three different 18-hole layouts: Red, Blue and Gold.

Each course covers undulating terrain and demands good course management from players of all levels. Even when the putts refuse to drop, the delightful rural views will always be enjoyed, framed by the natural backdrop of the Lucas Creek escarpment.

Ambitious players looking to lower their handicap are well provided for, with a personalised custom fitting service offered on-site by our in-house Pro Shop staff and a team of talented teaching professionals on hand to help and support.

Lessons focusing on all areas of the game are offered in the dedicated indoor studio. This is all backed up by some of the best practice facilities to be found in the area.

The club has a newly built Sprig Bar which provides a home from home to members. It is located downstairs with a view over the course and an outdoor seating area perfect for enjoying those sunny days.

The beautiful Functions Room upstairs takes advantage of the sweeping views over the course and makes a magnificent venue for special occasions, such as weddings, anniversaries, birthday celebrations or corporate functions.

The business community is equally well received, either to make use of our venue for that important meeting or to host a successful corporate golf day. North Shore Golf Club specialises in providing a unique experience for everyone visiting the club.



A BRIEF HISTORY

The North Shore Club was established in 1931, first occupying what is now known as the Thomas Park Municipal Course in Takapuna.

With little money but plenty of enthusiasm, the founding members employed their innate Kiwi "have a go skills" to turn farmland into an 18-hole course, that provided golfers with a more than satisfying round.

In 1959, the Auckland Harbour Bridge opened and land development on the North Shore began to explode. This expansion saw the Government seek land for a new Northern Motorway and a Civic Centre - with the North Shore Golf Club sitting in the middle of their plans.

While the Civic Centre never eventuated, the motorway proceeded, with a consequent reduction in availability of land to the club. Faced with an uncertain future, the members took the bold decision to develop a new course at Albany. Funds were available from a satisfactory negotiated settlement with the Government, which produced £181,000 to help the club relocate.

Since 1959 the North Shore Club courses have seen an ongoing programme of development and enhancement. New tees, greens, fairways and, in many instances, complete new holes have been introduced, resulting in an excellent layout. Not long by international standards, the course nevertheless requires clever shot-making and an appreciation of the subtleties of accurate golf.

Members and staff of the North Shore Club, past and present, deserve congratulations for the foresight, industry and expertise they have contributed to establishing one of the best-presented and most rewarding courses in New Zealand.





OUR COURSES

Sometimes challenging but always invigorating, the North Shore Golf Club layout provides a good test of golf to players of all abilities. The golf offered here at Albany is unique among clubs in Auckland, in that 27 holes are available for play.

This provides members with three different playing options from which to choose. Consisting of a Red, Blue and Gold course, each of the nines are challenging, yet very member friendly and having 27 holes at the club's disposal means different courses can be used for various events at the same time.

There is always a thrill and a sense of anticipation as you drive down Appleby Road, because you are not quite sure of what lies in store. Of course, there is always the incentive to play one's best, but which set of 18 holes will be laying down the challenge today? North Shore's best-kept secret is only revealed when the scorecard is printed! Members do not mind, because in all honesty all three sets of nine are equally strong, offering their own unique pitfalls and rewards, depending on the level of the player and how well they are playing.

The Red Course measure 5,985 metres (par 72), the Blue Course 5,965 metres (also par 72), and it's 5,942 metres for the Gold Course (again par 72). Perhaps not long, by today's standards, but don't let that fool you, with accuracy from the tees required to negotiate a combination of narrow tree-lined fairways and strategically designed short to medium length holes for golfers of all levels to enjoy. Some of the characteristics of this stunning golf course are:

- Manicured fairways, lined by a combination of native and exotic trees and shrubs;
- Green complexes that combine subtle undulating greens with strategically placed bunkers;
- A collection of holes that make you think about every shot;
- Several dams, providing a visual enhancement and golfing challenges; and
- Quality practice facilities to improve every facet of your game.

As the course is built on North Shore clays, playing conditions can change dramatically through the four seasons. Comprehensive drainage has overcome the problems of wet winters, while the installation of fairway watering in 1995 has extended ideal playing conditions beyond the traditional outstanding spring and autumn periods.



The Red Course (holes 1 through 18) begins by wandering along the banks of Lucas Creek, providing spectacular views and a playing environment to match. The second nine, located on the high side of the property, is equally challenging.

The Gold Course combines the views of the first nine and the forest-like environment of holes 19 through 27.

The Blue Course takes in holes 10 through 18 from the Red Course and holes 19 through 27 from the Gold, providing two completely different nines to enjoy and play.

Three wonderful, yet quite different, layouts combine to provide some of Auckland's best golfing.



HOLE-BY-HOLE GUIDE

We hope you enjoy your time with us at North Shore Golf Club. Here are a few useful tips and course notes which should help you make the most of your round, if you have never visited us before.

HOLE 1, 514 METRES, PAR 5

This is the longest par 5 on the course. The preferred drive is down the left-hand side to allow room to negotiate around the dog-leg right. The premium position to approach the green is from the left side of the fairway, which will take the front bunker out of play. The position of the tee shot is all important.

HOLE 2, 472 METRES, PAR 5

The preferred tee shot is at the left-hand bunker. The second shot will fall from left to right, with the contour of the fairway. The right side is the best location to approach the green from. Keep your approach to the pin below the hole.

HOLE 3, 346 METRES, PAR 4

Our stunning new 3rd hole – designed by Grant Puddicombe – opened for play on Saturday 29th April, 2017 and has already been described by visiting golfers as one of the best holes in Auckland. A gentle right-to-left dog-leg design, the perfect tee shot would be a 180m drive down the right side of the fairway, which following the natural right-to-left bias would bring the ball to rest left of centre, leaving the optimum angle for a 140m approach shot to the green. The more ambitious player might want to pull out driver and leave a shorter shot to the green, but with out of bounds down the left, this is a high risk and reward strategy.

HOLE 4, 137 METRES, PAR 3

HOLE 5, 335 METRES, PAR 4

The contour at the tee shot landing area will take the ball left, particularly in summer when drier conditions come into play. Longer hitters should consider an iron off the tee, leaving a short iron to the green. The distance for the second shot can be deceptive

and players should consider allowing for one extra club.

HOLE 6, 343 METRES, PAR 4

This is a testing par four that demands a reasonably long and well-placed tee shot. Any drive short and left will be shut out by the large pine tree on the right. Any approach landing over the green will be in trouble. Out of bounds along the left and contours right to left.

HOLE 7, 175 METRES, PAR 3

One of the more difficult par threes on the course. The front bunkers left and right will catch any shot that is slightly off line. Take plenty of club to ensure you reach a green that slopes from back to front.



HOLE 8, 269 METRES, PAR 4

One of the shorter par fours on the course, leaving the option of taking on the bunkers or laying up for the approach shot to the green. The ground falls away to the left of the green and to the rear. The green slopes from the back to front. Be aware of the greenside bunker with your approach.

HOLE 9, 390 METRES, PAR 4

A very demanding par four to finish off the first nine. The preferred tee shot is right of centre, to allow for the right-to-left slope of the fairway. Be sure to take note of where the flag is located on what is a long and narrow green and adjust club selection accordingly. A tee shot into the left rough could make par difficult.

HOLE 10, 483 METRES, PAR 5

A very demanding par five. The narrow landing area for the tee shot requires accuracy. A good drive will follow the contours to the left, leaving the optimum position to negotiate the dog-leg right. Take care your second shot does not go through the fairway. A long green is made more difficult when the pin is positioned back right.

HOLE 11, 373 METRES, PAR 4

One of the more difficult par fours on the course. A good tee shot is required right of the fairway bunker followed by an equally good second to a green that slopes back to front from right to left.

HOLE 12, 352 METRES, PAR 4

A tee shot aimed straight down the centre is the preferred alignment from the tee, provided the drive has sufficient length to see into the green. In summer conditions take care not to over club from the tee.

HOLE 13, 347 METRES, PAR 4

Stay left of centre from the tee to take the lake out of play – too far right and your ball will be wet. The green is narrow, so the approach shot needs to be accurate.

HOLE 14, 175 METRES, PAR 3

This par three is well guarded by bunkers front and rear. The front bunkers give the impression the hole is shorter than it is, so take plenty of club. Bail out position is right of the green.

HOLE 15, 355 METRES, PAR 4

Well-hit tee shots will go with the contour from right to left which is the preferred position for the approach. The green, whilst long, is quite narrow and made more difficult by the hazard at the back left of the green. Out of bounds right and a lateral hazard left.

HOLE 16, 153 METRES, PAR 3


An elevated tee down toward a well-protected green with front and side bunkers. Prevailing winds can dictate club selection.

HOLE 17, 314 METRES, PAR 4

The option from the tee is to play to the right of the fairway bunkers or to take the direct route over the left bunker. Be aware of the bunker left front of the green.

HOLE 18, 482 METRES, PAR 5

A tee shot played to the centre of the fairway gives the option of playing into the valley below the green or laying up above the valley. The green slopes from back to front. Any shot played through the green is in trouble.



HOLE 19, 339 METRES, PAR 4

The preferred line from the tee is right centre, which will take out the bunkers for the second shot. The green slopes right to left. An approach through the green will make par very difficult.

HOLE 20, 339 METRES, PAR 4

One of the more demanding par fours. The preferred alignment for the tee shot is left of the pine trees on the right side of the fairway. Take plenty of club for the approach and note the steep drop from the right greenside to the lateral water hazard.

HOLE 21, 327 METRES, PAR 4

A good drive starting out to the right side of the fairway will roll with the contour to the centre or left side of the fairway. This is the best position to approach the green. Avoid being blocked out by the large pine on the left.

HOLE 22, 124 METRES, PAR 3

The green slopes from back to front and from right to left. The area left of the green slopes steeply away. The hole plays longer than the distance would indicate.

HOLE 23, 505 METRES, PAR 5

This is not the longest par five on the course, it just plays that way. Uphill for the first and second shots to a narrow fairway flanked by trees. A well-positioned second shot will help set up a satisfying par.

HOLE 24, 282 METRES, PAR 4

The shortest par four on the course but by no means the easiest. A well-positioned drive is the key to playing this hole well. A sharp dog-leg right to a green shaped like an upturned saucer makes things very interesting.

HOLE 25, 485 METRES, PAR 5

A ball played left from the tee could create difficulties. The preferred line is right of centre, as the contour of the fairway will take the ball from right to left. The best approach line is from the left, taking the front bunker out of play.

HOLE 26, 417 METRES, PAR 4

The longest and most difficult par four on the course. Choose a line down the centre of the fairway for the tee shot. Follow this with a second shot down the left. The green slopes from left to right, as does the fairway in front of the putting surface for those coming up short.

HOLE 27, 143 METRES, PAR 3

The pin placement on this large three-tiered green ensures that club selection is critical. The green slopes from back to front and can leave some wicked putts for those whose tee shot ends up on the wrong level.







Smaller Social Groups will find North Shore to be an excellent choice for a memorable day of golf.


